I wish to bring to the attention of Sawtry parish council a problem we are having with vandalism, we live at no 110 green end road next to the shop and coop, We have a footpath between us and the coop, the footpath is included on the deeds to 110 green end road and we are responsible for ownership of the land granting access over this land to pedestrians using the footpath as normal.

We have recently had our fences vandalised twice smashing the panels beyond repair the cost of this will be about ?200.

I understand that other people along the footpath have also had similar damage and cost.

The problem is as I see it that the old fashioned bus shelter at the end of the footpath, being a brick built covered in shelter, is a magnet for undesirable people, signs of drug taking can be seen, down and outs spend hours sitting in there often sleeping it off. As we live here, it often falls to us to remove the rubbish and empty drug bottles into the bin you provide, they do not bother to use it.

I do not know who is responsible for this shelter, cleaning and maintenance, but would suggest its replacement for a modern one as provide on the other side of the road, this would give clear vision into the shelter so that police can observe as they pass by, the seating would also be less attractive to those trying to sleep it off.

Please make this known to council members and perhaps help us with these problems.

I took the time to point out to the council the problem of speeding down green end road, to date I have had no reply from you, and the problem continues to get worse if as I have said before someone gets injured by these irresponsible drivers I will be forced to say I told you so.
